Type 1: A fee of S\$50 (exclusive of GST) per interview, per usage will be levied for using archival materials for educational and cultural activities, for informational and illustrative purposes in academic publications, newsletters and public service broadcast programmes.

Type 2: A fee of S\$500.00 (exclusive of GST) per interview, per usage will be levied for using archival materials for product development and commercial use, for example all forms of merchandising, non-public service broadcast programmes and non-academic publications.
